

The regular monthly meeting of the Fox Township Board of Supervisors was held May 7, 2025, at 6:00 PM. Those present: Dave Mattiuz, Matt Pontzer, and Randy Gradizzi, supervisors, Kathy Dowie, secretary-treasurer, Rob Singer, Jim Nissel, Kaiden Bayer, and Marilyn Secco, newspaper reporter.

Chairman Mattiuz called the meeting to order and began acknowledging the visitors.

Kaiden Bayer stated that he would like to survey businesses in Kersey to see how the Township could help them. Dave Mattiuz replied that he was fine with that, provided that Kaiden does not indicate that he is affiliated with the Township. His goal is to help small businesses. Bayer presented the board with a few questions that he intended to ask these businesses.

There were no other visitor comments.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Randy Gradizzi to approve the minutes from the meeting of April 2, 2025. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Randy Gradizzi stated that he spoke with Seneca Resources about the trail proposal presented at the previous meeting. Seneca was receptive to the idea and is going to provide a map showing where the trail can be located.

Randy Gradizzi stated that the Gardner Hill Road project was approved for Dirt and Gravel Road funding. The project will consist of raising the elevation of approximately 2000 feet of the road by 2 feet and installing three new cross drains.

NEW BUSINESS

A copy of the Limited Procedures Engagement of the Fox Township Relief Association for the period of January, 2021 thru December, 2023 was received and is available for review.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to advertise for bids for the purchase of the following: 1,000 ton 1B limestone, 2,000 ton 2A limestone and 10,000 gallons MC70 Dust Oil. Motion carried.

The Fox Township Planning Commission reviewed the following subdivision and recommended it for approval:
Lori Decker, Stephen Leasgang and Lisa Mazza are subdividing their parcel of land located along the Million Dollar Highway. Tract "A", 12.864 acres, will be conveyed to and combined with the lands of Lori Decker containing an existing home. The residual lot, 15.149 acres, will remain a non-building lot. The subdivision also creates a 50-foot right-of-way between these two parcels.

A motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Matt Pontzer to approve this subdivision as presented. Motion carried.

The following applications for use of facilities were submitted for approval:

Fox Twp Farmers Market – Community Park, Thursdays June-October

Dickinson Center – Community Park, July 9th, Storytime Walk Event

Fox Twp Soccer – Community Park and Community Bldg. (in inclement weather), June 16-20, Soccer camp

A motion was made by Dave Mattiuz, seconded by Matt Pontzer to approve these applications as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Matt Pontzer, seconded by Dave Mattiuz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried with Pontzer and Mattiuz in favor. Randy Gradizzi was in favor of the motion but abstained from check #30138 and check #1655 to St. Marys Water, as he sits on the Board.

OTHER BUSINESS

Dave Mattiuz thanked Rebco for their donation towards the concrete work done at the Angela Huey Field.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Randy Gradizzi, seconded by Dave Mattiuz, to adjourn this meeting at 6:16 PM. Motion carried.
